Peer-Learning Workshop on Building a Local Government Alliance for Localising New Urban Agenda (NUA) and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

09-10 December 2018 in Guangzhou, China

Background

In 2014, the United Nations (UN) stated that 54% of the world's population are already living in cities and this will continue to increase to reach 66% in 2050. A 2015 UNHABITAT report showed that the speed and scope of urbanisation in Asia and the Pacific is unprecedented and between 1980 and 2010, the region's cities grew by around one billion people. By 2050, the number of people living in cities in China and India alone will grow by 696 million (India 404 million; China 292 million).

This urbanisation transforms urban areas into the centre of concentration of the population, social and cultural interactions, environmental and humanitarian impacts, and economic activities. The pressure on environmental conditions in the city will be even greater, giving rise to a greater potential for disasters.

In the Asia-Pacific region, the United Cities and Local Governments Asia Pacific (UCLG ASPAC) has been actively involved in localising the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 2030 at the local level through the peer learning and training programme. Another highly relevant global agenda that needs to be localised is the New Urban Agenda (NUA). Therefore, references or guidelines for implementing SDGs and NUA at local levels are needed.

For this reason, to support the realisation of the achievement of urban development goals especially the NUA, UCLG ASPAC, in conjunction with Guangzhou Awards 2018, is organising the Peer-Learning Workshop on "Building a Local Government Alliance for Localising New Urban Agenda (NUA) and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 2015-2030 in Asia-Pacific" to be held in Guangzhou, China.

Expected Outcomes

The workshop will look into concrete examples of SDGs and NUA practice and its outcomes, identify the specifics of knowledge localisation process and impacts on local stakeholders, and define ways to effectively localise the global agendas (SDGs, NUA, etc). This will also be an opportunity for urban experts from local governments to network and seek advice from cities that have successfully implemented activities on SDGs and which may provide an opportunity for city-to-city cooperation.

The workshop aims to:

1. Link the Asian cities network with international organisations and expertise from cities with local practices highlighted through the Guangzhou award and other cities in the region;
2. Share approaches on localising SDGs and NUA by providing information to local governments and other stakeholders about Practical Guidelines in the framework of NUA Implementation;

3. Enhance the connectivity of global agendas, particularly SDGs and the New Urban Agenda; and
4. Identify transferable lessons and practices and make them accessible through good documentation.

Methodology and Work Process

The two-day workshop is structured into four sessions which build upon each other. After the introduction of the local contexts of SDGs and NUA, the first session will involve a discussion of the cross-cutting issues on the global agenda. In the second session, invited participants primarily from municipalities and local government associations in Asia and the Pacific will present their good practices on the implementation of SDGs and NUA. The third session provides an opportunity to participants to present challenges in localising SDGs and to receive concrete and practical recommendations through peer-to-peer consultation. This will also be compared with the contents of guidelines and work plans of the institutions. Participants will work on the recommendations for local level transfer of good practices to respond to SDGs and NUA localisation efforts. In the fourth session, a roadmap for localizing SDGs and NUA will be discussed. Partners will also agree on key messages to be incorporated in the UCLG ASPAC work plan and produce a Peer Learning Note (outcome document).
